Senior makes history as first APW High School graduate to receive an associate degree

Altmar-Parish-Williamstown senior Peyton Flanagan received his high school diploma in late June, but it wasn't his first time walking across a graduation stage. In May he graduated magna cum laude with an associate degree in humanities and social sciences from Onondaga Community College. This makes him the first APW student to graduate high school in four years with a college degree, and one of only few to do so at OCC.

Thanks to APW's partnership with OCC and APW facilitator Beth Dunham, Flanagan was able to join the Early College Program when he was in ninth grade. He began taking advanced and college courses via distance learning to earn 30 college credits by the end of his junior year, allowing him to spend his senior year full time on the OCC campus.

Adding to his achievements, Flanagan has been awarded a Dean's Scholarship to American University School of International Service in Washington, D.C., where he'll be studying international relations with concentrations in foreign policy and national security.

At the age of 16, Flanagan was one of only 500 students globally selected to attend Harvard University's summer program where he studied international law and world conflict. His passion for reading and his interests in military and global events have driven his academic pursuits.

Flanagan's parents, Bruce and Mary Ellen, attribute his success to the support of the school district. "His teachers, coaches, advisors and administrators all played a crucial role in guiding Peyton along this journey," they said. "We truly appreciate everything the district has done and without them it wouldn't have been possible."

William Francisco, a junior at Altmar-Parish-Williamstown, has been selected from a competitive applicant pool to attend the 2024 Project Fibonacci® STEAM Leadership Conference in August.

Themed "The Smart Machine and the Human Factor," this conference will gather students from across New York state for a weeklong exploration of Artificial Intelligence.

Participants will engage in hands-on learning activities that combine artistic and scientific critical thinking skills with collaboration and teamwork. They will explore pressing issues facing society while learning from expert researchers, entrepreneurs and educators.

Francisco, whose passion for computer science led him to pursue coding at CiTi BOCES, expressed his excitement about the opportunity. "I'm fascinated by computer science

fields such as AI," he said. "This conference is a chance for me to deepen my understanding of how it works."

APW Director of Instructional Technology, Diane Bush, spoke on behalf of the selection committee which also included Principal Jenn O'Malley and Assistant Principal Tim LaRose. "After careful review of numerous applications and conducting thorough interviews, we unanimously agreed that Francisco was the ideal candidate to represent APW at the conference," Bush said. The Project Fibonacci® Foundation is a leader in promoting science, technology, engineering, arts and math (STEAM) educational opportunities in New York state.
